

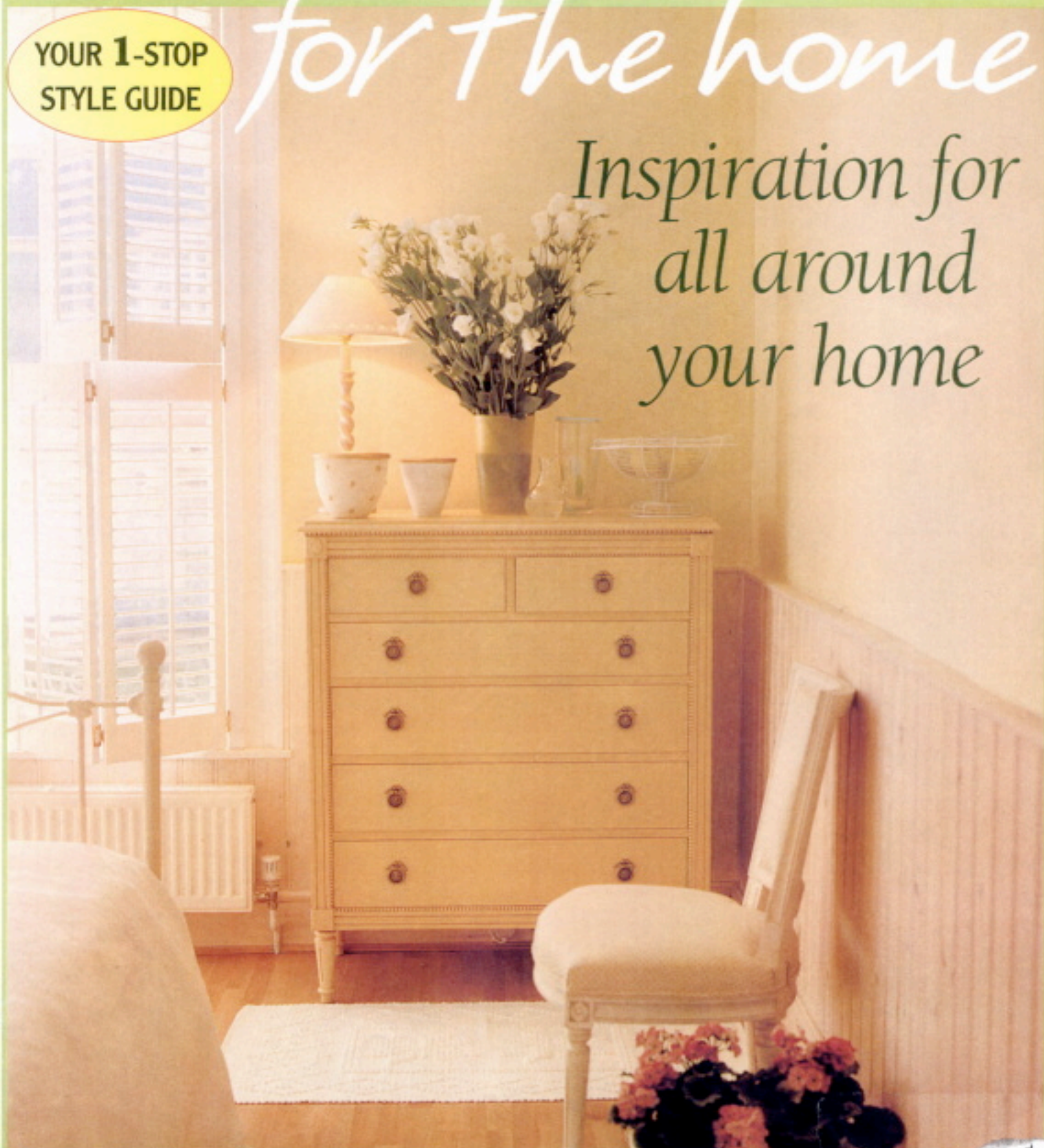

Storage

To make sense of its odd shape and unify the room, we asked a local carpenter to build a wardrobe into the alcove next to the corner window. This was linked to the window by a decorative framed window seat with a shaped pelmet above. He used pine, finished with Ronseal's Home & Garden Woodfinish in White, for a lime washed look.

Lighting

White louvered shutters can filter daylight or create a cosy, secure feeling at night. Table lamps provide a warm and intimate glow.

Style

As well as creating a feeling of quality, the tongue and groove panelling makes a perfect country style background, especially good against Swedish style furniture. We chose a reproduction cast iron bed to complete the look. Striped voile draped through a loop hung above the bed, is scooped back and held by a curtain pole. We laid a beautiful, beech laminate floor by Pergo, and to complement this, tongue and groove panelling was installed to dado height and then finished as the wardrobe. Light woods like these really make the most of available light.

Colour

Green and cream are arguably the most restful bedroom colours. Surrounded by leafy green wallpaper by Jane Churchill and bedlinen from The White Company, the room feels calm.
